  - Designing and building a web and WPF-based application to manage road maintenance surveys. This included importing data from a number of GIS data sources, utilising WPF for a data-collection device, visualisation of road condition data using Google Maps, and exporting data to a number of different formats.
  - Architecting an enterprise application using WCF services to track and manage joints and bolts in large-scale oil and gas installations, refineries and rigs. This included making technology decisions around the use of Silverlight, HTML5 and WPF, and designing a service-based architecture utilising WCF services to ensure future extensibility.
